













Youth Climate Ambassador Conference

As part of its Youth Climate Ambassador Program, Project Survival Pacific (PSP) is organizing the Youth Climate Ambassador Conference for young people from Fiji and other Pacific island countries to come together and decide how they could become more proactive in addressing the Pacific's climate change and other sustainable development challenges.

The Youth Climate Ambassador Conference, to be held on 20 November in Lautoka and on 21 November in Suva, will be a gathering of young people with the theme "Truth in Action" focusing on sharing the truth of what the climate crisis means for the Pacific community; how we can solve the crisis; and discover how together we can make a real difference in our community. The thematic areas covered will be, but not limited to climate change, oceans, health, green entrepreneurship, food, security, adaptation, mitigation and loss and damage.

Between 20 and 21 November 2019, Climate Reality Project is organizing the 24 Hour of Reality Truth in Action - a global conversation on the truth of the climate crisis and how we solve it. Here in Fiji, Project Survival Pacific's Youth Climate Ambassador Program and Climate Reality's 24 Hour of Reality will come together to harness the power of truth in action and the innovative minds of the youth to channel in new ideas of how to address climate change in the Pacific.
